

Introduction to Facilitation – Part I: a training for aspiring equine-assisted learning facilitators

This four day training is open to four participants.

You will learn to set up an equine-assisted learning/therapy program and to facilitate equine-assisted learning exercises.

Agenda:

The first two mornings are spent inside learning the programming – safety, structure and programming. The first two afternoons and the whole day of day three are spent outside practicing the equine-assisted learning/therapy exercises.

These days run from 9am – 4pm with an hour for lunch. Wendy Elrick is the facilitator.

Day four runs from 9am – 2pm and is focussed on how to care for a herd who is facilitating healing work.
